Uncertainty has not yet come home to roost for this year's listed firms

Top 400 Contractors say cracks in consumer confidence are becoming more evident as owners cancel some projects and pause others amid confusion over the Trump administration's "America First" agenda.

"We are only a few months into the second term of the Trump administration, so it is probably a little premature to say what the downstream market impacts are of these policies," says Keith Poettker, chairman and CEO of Poettker Construction Co. Even so, the executive still believes the "long-term strategy" of America First will "create robust manufacturing growth expansion in the U.S. driven by both foreign direct investment and domestic manufacturing capital improvement expansion."

However, in the short term, contractors say uncertainty over new economic policies has added another layer of risk to an increasingly complex market.

"Tariffs, inflation, fluctuating interest rates, shifting consumer sentiment and geopolitical tensions—all have real implications for project viability and cost," says Erik Haslem, CEO of contractor BHI. "They reflect the broader volatility we're seeing across the AEC industry."

Top 400 contractors reported \$600 billion in total revenue last year—up 7.9% for listed firms even as they balance limited labor resources against rising construction costs and rapidly shifting project demands.

Clayco CEO Anthony Johnson says labor shortages "remain a persistent issue" in the industry, "impacting timelines and productivity." Adding to that, Johnson says "changes in policies, client demands and economic conditions re-

quire agility and proactive planning," which can put more pressure on labor resources to prevent projects from being shelved.

Johnson says that Clayco, like many Top 400 firms, is focused on "building resilient teams, investing in workforce development and adapting our operations to stay ahead of where the market is going."

According to economists, the deployment of Trump's tariff policy over the next few months will be key in determining that direction.

Shifting Politics, Policies and Priorities

For some Top 400 firms, collateral damage from tariff hikes already is evident. Gabe Rodriguez, Barton Malow vice president of strategy and environmental analysis, says tariffs have "significantly impacted" the contractor's business.

"As a Michigan-based contractor with close ties to Canada, we have been very vigilant about our procurement strategy," he says. The company identified a tariff risk of \$15 million, or 50%, of materials costs, on a client's planned purchase of \$30 million in curtainwall material from a Canadian facility. Rodriguez says his team found a domestic alternative with a guar-

anteed price increase cap of \$3.9 million that "would not fluctuate with changes in tariff policy."

He adds, "Cost uncertainty drives a lot of risk for our clients, and they are actively seeking ways to reduce their construction cost uncertainty in this environment."

Jeff Bean, Q&D Construction president of heavy/civil, says he expects "suppliers are going to stop honoring their prices and contractors are going to look to owners for reimbursement of additional costs."

He adds, "It is adding serious uncertainty and risk. We don't know what products are affected from where, when or at what magnitude."

Market Movers and Shakers

All of the key construction markets that ENR tracks grew between 2023-24, with the exception of industrial process projects, which fell 9.9%. Telecommunications saw the largest growth, up 59.7% from last year, and 188.5% since 2021. Sewer and waste rose 23.7%; power was up 18.9%; oil and gas grew 16.6% and transportation climbed 11.4%. The sewer and waste market has increased 71.7% over the past two years.

Among Top 400 listed firms, HITT Contracting and Holder Construction both reported large revenue jumps driven by work in telecommunications.

“Unlike consumer spending, which quickly responds to economic changes, the commercial construction industry is buffered by a backlog of funded projects,” says HITT CEO Kim Roy. “As a result, we typically feel the impact of a contraction 12 to 18 months later than other sectors.”

Total domestic revenue for Top 400 contractors increased 8.7%, to \$567.1 billion in 2024. Firms also reported a strong rise in domestic new contract totals between 2023 and 2024, up 14.4% to \$588 billion. Median new contract totals rose 7.7% to \$669.02 million.

Also, 97.1% of reporting firms say they made a domestic profit, in line with previous years.

Ups and Downs

Median firm revenue stayed virtually flat between 2023-24, after rising double digits during the previous two Top 400 survey cycles. Of 375 firms that filed both this year and last, 64.8% reported an increase in revenue. The previous reading for that number was 77.3%. Overall, 57.5% of reporting firms say they have a higher backlog than on last year’s list, slightly up from the 2024 Top 400 proportion, but still down substantially from 72.7% two years ago. Just over 25% of firms on the 2025 survey say their backlogs have shrunk.

Related to non-U.S. markets, revenue dropped 5.1% from 2023-24, to \$33.5 billion from \$35.3 billion. This continues a long-term trend of Top 400 Contractors moving away from work outside the country. In 2015, 84 of the Top 400 reported some international general contracting revenue, making up 19% of their total revenue that year. In 2025, 56 firms reported non-U.S. revenue making up only 5.5% of the total.

Kitchell Corp. CEO Wendy Cohen says the contractor is “seeing volatility” amid shifts in federal funding and “looming tariff discussions” which could “drive up costs.” However, Cohen adds that, “at the same time, there’s a lot of momentum—

clients are eager to build. It’s a complex moment in the market, but one filled with opportunity.”

Bechtel says the firm notes strong demand for general contracting services in nuclear power, LNG, critical minerals and advanced manufacturing. The contracting giant attributes the demand to a global push for cleaner energy and “a sharper focus on secure, domestic supply chains,” adds Peter Nelson, manager of corporate planning.

“Our projects are advancing, and we’re seeing strong growth across the business,” says Nelson.

Leveraging Labor Resources

Top 400 firms say they expect last year’s challenges to carry over into this year, with many amplified by dwindling labor pools and availability.

“Labor scarcity can impact our ability to scale quickly, meet aggressive schedules and deliver the level of quality we expect on every job,” says Rick Davenport, president and COO of Samet Corp. “This challenge is not unique to us—it’s systemic in the AEC industry.”

In response, the firm is doubling down on proposed solutions, such as investing in workforce development and supervision, he says, “ensuring we have well-trained, engaged field leaders who can support our teams and trade partners.”

Davenport says that includes “everything from recognition programs to building covered wellness areas on the jobsite where our trade partners can take breaks from the heat, warm their food and have a clean place to sit and enjoy their lunch.”

The Trump administration crackdown on undocumented U.S. workers and its

immigration policies more generally have added to labor pressures for some Top 400 firms as they look to recruit and retain talent internationally.

“We’re closely monitoring labor and immigration changes as they directly impact our workforce,” says Vincent Lai, vice president of estimating at Bernards. “Our proactive approach includes mentorship, training programs, competitive wages and fostering a diverse and inclusive workplace. These efforts help us retain and grow talent while preparing for future shifts in workforce policy.”

Innovating Under Pressure

In the face of market challenges, Top 400 firms say shifting market conditions have been an opportunity for them to innovate operations and home in on the work they do best as contractors.

Knutson says it secured projects in the education and health care sectors over the past year came by “concentrating our efforts in markets where we excel.”

Joeris General Contractors President Burton Hackney says the firm has been able to scale operations while maintaining its culture and talent. “Through highly intentional talent development initiatives and leadership mentoring programs, we’ve successfully preserved our collaborative, client-focused culture,” he adds.

Jim Radich, recently retired Granite Construction chief operating officer and executive vice president, says the firm has had numerous projects on which it has been able to bake innovations into the design and permitting stages to reduce risk and save time and money. The company says it is continuing to focus on early contractor involvement and qualifications-based selection procurement.

“All markets are facing ongoing uncertainty around geopolitical issues, tariffs, interest rates supply chain disruptions and labor constraints,” says William “Bill” H. Goodrich, Chairman and CEO of LeChase Construction Services LLC. “Rather than take an alarmist view, we choose to be realistic and responsive in how we navigate the challenges,” he says.



New Office Tower Includes Transit Access

Turner is constructing a 46-story building that will connect to Grand Central

REDEVELOPMENT

The MTA's former headquarters will be a fully electrified building with a major financial tenant.

Turner Construction has started building a 46-story commercial office tower on Madison Avenue in Manhattan. The 930,000-sq-ft project, designed by Kohn Pederson Fox, includes an underground entrance that will provide access to Grand Central's Madison Concourse between 44th and 45th Street.

"We are honored to contribute to a project that not only enhances the iconic New York City skyline but also improves access to public transit," said Luigi Morfea, construction executive at Turner Construction Co., in a statement.

The building will house 40 workplace floors with floorplates ranging from 27,500 sq ft at the podium to 21,500 sq ft in the tower. Specialty floors include private terraces and those with elevated ceilings.

A double-height club on the top floors will provide spaces for dining and relaxation. Amenities will include bicycle storage with lockers and showers.

The team is targeting LEED Platinum, WELL Core, Energy Star 85+, Fitwel and WiredScore Platinum certifications. The fully electric tower will operate with zero on-site combustion, and a

high-efficiency direct outside air system aims to provide climate resiliency. An investment-grade financial institution is set to anchor 30% of the building.

BXP was selected in 2020 to redevelop the site, which housed the Metropolitan Transportation Authority's headquarters until 2014. MTA retains ownership of the land. BXP agreed to build the underground entrance in advance of the office tower.

Demolition began in Feb. 2021; the transit entrance is scheduled to complete in spring of 2026.

Upgrading a Link in California's Capital City

Rehab of the American River Bridge in Sacramento addresses spall, scour

The \$239.5-million rehab of the American River Bridge in Sacramento, Calif., will reach a milestone this month, with the CM/GC joint venture of Granite Construction Inc. and California Engineering Contractors completing final deck pours.

Built in 1954 as separate northbound and southbound two-lane spans, the 1.5-mile crossing linking

downtown and eastern Sacramento was expanded to three lanes in 1966 without additional structural support. Since then, the deck has had extensive cracking and spalling, with severe scour around foundation piles.

Early collaboration with state regulators enabled the team to expedite the permitting process and begin construction in Jan. 2022, while design was still underway.

The project includes nine new 50-ft-wide piers, ranging in height from 40 ft to 60 ft; 15 bents averaging 30 ft in height; and the superstructure for the replacement of the existing deck.

To protect the river and its wintertime salmon runs, much of the work is performed from barges, with dewatered sheetpile cofferdams providing access to pier footings for scour mitigation.

According to Granite, the next phase calls for shifting State Route 51 traffic back to original alignments and starting construction on the Class 1 bike path along the bridge. Scheduled for completion next summer, the widened crossing will have four full shoulders, with one HOV lane in each direction. New soundwalls and seismic upgrades are also part of the project, funded by California's State Highway Operation and Protection Program and an Active Transportation Program grant.

US Commercial Uranium Enrichment Expands

tors and weapons. It was the nation's only operating uranium enrichment facility when it was closed in 2013, having been under lease since 1993 to produce material for commercial nuclear reactors. Since then, DOE has overseen efforts to remediate site groundwater contamination and deactivate facilities for demolition.

Last year, Global Laser Enrichment announced purchase of a 665-acre parcel adjacent to the Paducah site for a facility that will use laser technology, rather than centrifuges, to enrich uranium from DOE waste byproducts. The firm has submitted environmental and safety analyses for federal review, with plans to begin plant operation by 2030.

EnCore Energy also has begun building new in-situ recovery facilities at its Upper Spring Creek uranium project in Texas. Under an extended state radioactive materials license, work includes site preparation, wellfield construction, new support infrastructure and pouring of concrete foundations for a new satellite ion exchange unit linked to a central uranium processing plant in Rosita. It expects to begin recovering uranium by the end of the year and increase production in 2026.

General Matter, a nuclear energy firm, has signed a lease with the U.S. Energy Dept. to build a \$1.5-billion commercial uranium enrichment facility at the former federal Paducah Gaseous Diffusion Plant in Paducah, Ky., to expand U.S. nuclear power.

Backed by tech entrepreneur Peter Thiel, the San Francisco company has provided few details about the planned facility on a 100-acre parcel at the site where defense-related uranium enrichment occurred for more than 60 years. Construction is set to begin next year, with enrichment operations planned for 2034 using what the firm calls "a novel, scalable, cost-competitive technology." No con-

General Matter is one of four companies the government chose in 2024 to provide enrichment services to develop a domestic supply of high-assay, low-enriched uranium for power critical to reshored advanced manufacturing and data centers, says DOE. The lease also provides General Matter with at least 7,600 cylinders of existing uranium hexafluoride to supply fuel for future re-enrichment operations. Reprocessing it will save about \$800 million in disposal costs, it says.

The lease is part of a federally owned 3,556-acre tract near Paducah selected by the federal government in 1950 for a gaseous diffusion uranium enrichment plant designed to support military reac-



Ferrovial Expands in US Solar Power Sector

Spain-based global infrastructure firm Ferrovial said Aug. 26 it is investing about \$355 million to develop a 250-MW solar power facility in Milam County, Texas, for which it will manage construction, operation and maintenance. The project would produce power by 2027, delivering about 450 GWh annually to the Texas grid. Construction is set to begin in the coming months, generating nearly 300 jobs, said María José Esteruelas, Ferrovial Energy CEO. The company said it also expects to produce 475 GWh of power annually by next year from a plant in Leon County it is building and will operate, with its \$72-million investment the firm's first in a U.S. renewable project. Ferrovial also is building a 72-MW solar plant with 60 MW battery energy storage system in Houston for Spain-based renewable and energy storage developer X-Elio. That firm said it has operated solar power in Mexico (see photo) since 2018. *By Debra K. Rubin*

What's Next After LNG Canada Startup?

Expansion study launched but no final investment yet, as energy markets shift

MARKET BOOST

LNG Canada's export terminal in Kitimat, B.C., finally started up this year, with Fluor and JGC hired to engineer an expansion.

Days that the U.S. Energy Dept. ordered regional grid operator PJM Interconnection, on Aug. 26, to keep operating in Pennsylvania the 760-MW natural gas-and-oil-fired Eddystone power plant, citing a 2025 Donald Trump "energy emergency" order. Two Eddystone units set to retire on May 31 are staying online until Nov. 26, although DOE said operation of the plant, owned by Constellation Energy Corp., "will continue in the near term and also likely... in subsequent years." Advocacy groups and regulators in several PJM states are appealing the emergency order.

Selection last month of Fluor Corp. and JGC Corp. as front-end engineering and design contractor for Phase 2 of the massive LNG Canada liquefied natural gas export terminal in British Columbia was a hopeful sign to that sector that its newly opened 14-million-ton-per-year predecessor would have a final investment decision to build a companion.

The joint venture, EPC contractor for the first phase, now is developing a plan to add two new trains to possibly double its processing, storage and shipping capacity as some markets show new potential. The plant is said to be the first of its kind in Canada, with greenhouse gas intensity described as 35% lower than current best performing LNG plants globally, and about 60% below the worldwide average.

Still unclear is timing for the next phase, which project owners, led by Shell, have not confirmed, but media say may not open until the early 2030s. Also to be determined are expansion details for TC Energy's Coastal GasLink pipeline that would supply the larger export terminal, as well as plans to electrify production with more potential hydropower. "We look forward to contributing to the next chapter in construction of this world-class facility," said Mike Alexander, president of Fluor's energy group.

Six smaller LNG projects also are developing, representing \$109 billion in capital investment if all are built, said Natural Resources Canada, including the \$10-billion Ksi Lisims project that could reach an investment decision this year. But there are skeptics as to how fast

Canada's late-starting LNG boom can progress. Ed Crooks, Americas vice chair of energy consultant Wood Mackenzie, points to strong national opposition.

But shifts in global gas supply and in Canadian politics seem to favor growth of the first North American LNG export region with direct access to the Pacific Ocean, offering low-cost natural gas and shorter routes to Asia compared to U.S. Gulf Coast facilities.

Europeans have also been expressing interest in Canada's gas supply. Energy and Natural Resources Minister Tim Hodgson told Reuters Aug. 27 of talks with German officials "who believe there will be more LNG required and for longer as a transition fuel," citing AI power demand and need to shift more quickly from Russia- and China-sourced energy.

The election this year of centrist Prime Minister Mark Carney and new global tariff tensions with U.S. President Donald Trump also could spur energy projects forward.

Carney said the government may release details this month of a plan to fast-track approval of new pipeline and port infrastructure to support Atlantic LNG exports. One port location eyed is Churchill, Manitoba, on the Hudson Bay in the province's far north that Hodgson described as a "five- to seven-year" development.

Texas and Louisiana LNG Projects Are Set to Move Closer to FID

Two LNG export projects gained U.S. approvals Aug. 29, moving both closer to capacity expansion final investment decisions this year, said their developers, Next Decade and Kimmeridge. Despite opponent objections, the U.S. Federal Energy Regulatory Commission upheld Texas-based Rio Grande LNG's prior okay for two trains to boost

capacity to 27 tons per year, one year after an appeals court ordered more review. The U.S. Energy Dept. also granted final OK for the 9.5-million-tpy Commonwealth LNG in Louisiana to export to countries lacking free trade pacts with the U.S. Bechtel and Technip are EPC contractors for Rio Grande and Commonwealth, respectively.

Water Quality Project Reaches Milestone

Part of \$341-million California ultraviolet treatment plant will be 65 ft underground

LIMITED ACCESS

Construction crew maneuvers to build ultraviolet disinfection drinking water treatment plant located 65 ft underground at East Bay Municipal Utility District site in Orinda, Calif.

Construction on a \$341-million water quality improvement project for California's East Bay Municipal Utility District reached the halfway mark this summer as crews began concrete pours at portions of a large drinking water treatment facility located 65 ft beneath ground level.

The project, expected to complete in 2027, will upgrade the existing Orinda, Calif., treatment plant and replace aging chemical treatment components with ultraviolet disinfection and chlorine.

The utility district identified the need for the project in 2017 when

it changed its primary water source from the Mokelumne River to the Sacramento River and realized the need for improved water quality in light of climate change fluctuations.

Flatiron Dragados is prime contractor on the project, which will introduce ultraviolet disinfection and a chlorine contact basin to improve treatment processes and reduce formation of disinfection byproducts. Members of the design team include Carollo Engineers, Stantec and Arcadis.

The project requires a two-level excavation—supporting a tunnel-boring operation above and con-

crete slab construction below—that has demanded staged bracing and innovative sequencing to maintain stability and progress.

Crews currently are focused on the two-level excavation for both the ultraviolet disinfection and chlorine contact basin structures, with the slab that forms the roof of the UV chamber serving as the base of a two-story maintenance and electrical building.

Project manager Jared Herrington says that the team has carefully sequenced work on the project to keep construction on track.

Building to Boost Capacity and Resilience

Roche subsidiary Genentech plans its first East Coast manufacturing plant



BIOTECH BOOM

Genentech highlighted North Carolina's skilled workforce, with a number of companies building in the area.

Genentech, a South San Francisco, Calif.-based subsidiary of European biotech company Roche Group, plans to build a \$700-million manufacturing facility in North Carolina.

The 700,000-sq-ft high-volume fill-finish plant would produce metabolic medicines, bolstering both Genentech's production capacity and its supply chain resilience, according to the company. It would be Genentech's first East Coast manufacturing facility.

The plant is scheduled to finish and begin operating by 2029. A Genentech spokesperson said the

company currently had no information to share publicly about the project's contractor selection.

North Carolina Gov. Josh Stein (D) announced Genentech's selection of a site in Holly Springs, N.C., last May. "These companies know that our life science workforce is ready to help them deliver their cutting-edge medicines to the world," he said in a statement.

The 100-acre lot includes room for expansion, the company noted.

In a statement, Genentech CEO Ashley Magargee credited the U.S. Dept. of Commerce's U.S. Investment Accelerator program with

helping the project clear its permitting. President Donald Trump directed the program's creation via executive order in March to "facilitate and accelerate" investment in the U.S. The program is now also responsible for the department's CHIPS Program Office, which was established by the Biden administration to support semiconductor chip manufacturing and R&D projects.

The program is "remov[ing] regulatory barriers that cause delays in establishing manufacturing sites in the U.S.," Magargee said.
